
Tours depart from our riverside jetty below the Kuranda Railway/Skyrail Stations, over the railway footbridge and down the stairs.

## "Paradise Kuranda" Guided Rainforest Walk with Light Refreshments

Hop aboard the Kuranda Riverboat and cruise across the Barron River to a secluded rainforest clearing where you will be taken on a guided interpretive walk through a section of beautiful tropical rainforest. Under the rainforest's closed canopy lies a moist, shaded world of immense beauty and unsurpassed richness. Your guide will accompany you on an established trail, first used in the 1920s, and show you different examples of tropical rainforest trees, vines, lianas and ferns. Sometimes cassowaries are seen during the walk too. At the end of your guided walk you will be served tea, coffee and cake in our outdoor rainforest tea room.
