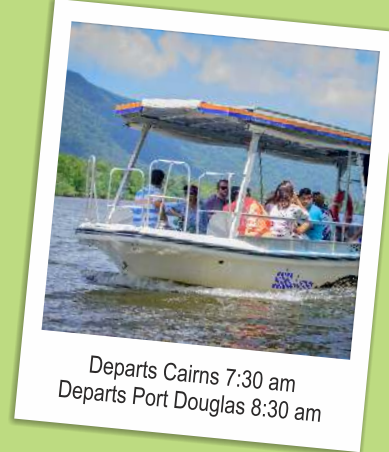

Departing from Cairns at 7:30am, head north towards the Daintree; an area of ancient tropical rainforest spanning 120,000 hectares, making it the largest portion of tropical rainforest in Australia. Walk the 2.5 Kilometer quiet track to witness the complex ecosystems in this World Heritage Area, with time to enjoy a swim in the incredible fresh water gorge.

At the Daintree Tea House, lunch has an exotic theme. The outside dining area is beautiful and exclusive with views of the tropical rainforest and continuous sounds of birds and nature.

After lunch we travel to the Daintree River for our Wildlife Cruise. The surroundings are full of opportunities to observe and photograph some of the most primitive forms of animal and plant life in the world.

Most days we experience great bird life and crocodile activity.

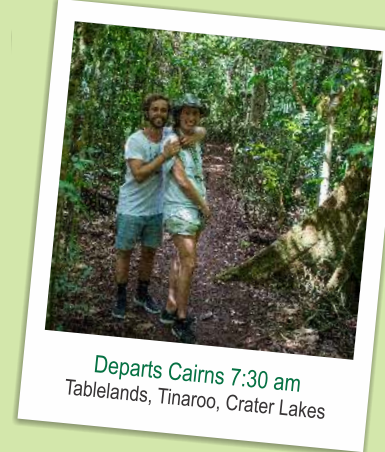

On this spectacular Tablelands adventure, we visit the ancient Cathedral Fig Tree. An 800 year old relic of the flora kingdom. Learn about the intricate life story of the Giant Fig while enjoying morning chorus. Over 120 birds can be found and heard in the area.

Travelling on to Lake Barrine for some beautiful morning tea, your guide will take you on a journey through the lakeside rainforest. Enjoy a one hour lake cruise for more wildlife opportunities. Listen out for our Bird of Paradise, the Victoria's Rifle Bird and many other elusive creatures.

We continue on our way for a delicious seafood lunch and some Platypus spotting!

To finish off the day, we take in the fantastic panoramas of Milla Milla lookout and a nice long swim or simply relax at Lake Eacham, often a highlight and a pleasant cool off.

Returning to Cairns approximately 5:30pm

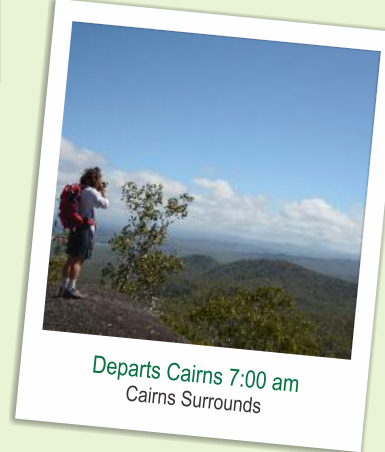

The only guided Hiking Experience in Cairns! Don't expect see much traffic on the walk! Perfect right? Beautiful Lamb Range is an hour drive West of Cairns and towers high above the Dinden National Park surrounds.

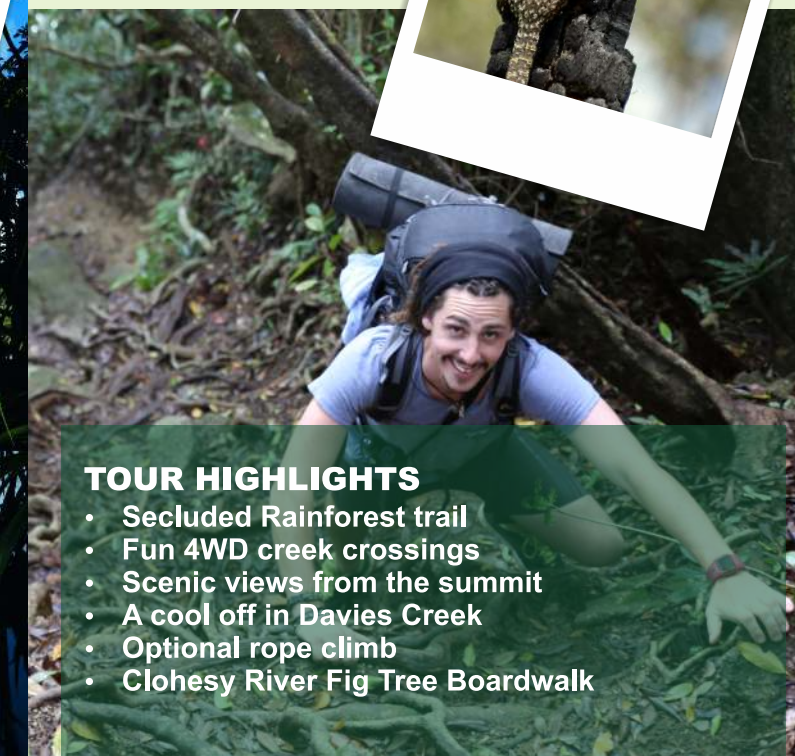
Expect an early start! We like to begin our hikes while the birds are singing and our wildlife are becoming active. The track consists of open woodland, giant gum trees, savanna habitat and beautiful iconic Xanthorrhoea grass trees. As we gain height we'll notice abrupt granite boulders coursing the summit area, providing spectacular scenery.

We will provide our guests with snacks and fruit to keep your energy high while on the hike. On our return from the walk, we'll travel a short distance to Davies Creek for our picnic lunch and a swim!

The trail is a 10 kilometer experience of a lifetime. The Rainforest habitat near the summit with it's beautiful Oraniopsis palms and Cycads will amaze you! Experience the smells and sounds of the ancient Wet Tropical Rainforest.

We have access to several mountain ranges to allow guests of all fitness levels the opportunity to enjoy our Hiking Tour.
