ADVICE FOR DIVING AND SNORKELING

Snorkeling and Scuba Diving can be strenuous activities. Some medications and medical conditions e.g. asthma, diabetes, heart or lung disease may prevent or limit your participation. If you are unsure, please contact us for more information or consult a diving physician. It is recommended that you do not fly for 24 hours after diving.

MEDICAL AND TRAVEL INSURANCE RECOMMENDED

All passengers are strongly advised to purchase a comprehensive Travel Insurance policy that covers:
 (i) Trip Cancellation or Rescheduling
 (ii) Lost / damaged personal belongings or equipment, due to any reason, and
 (iii) Evacuation and Medical cover including Scuba Diving.
 Note: In a medical emergency, any evacuation, vessel relocation or medical expenses are the final responsibility of that passenger. Divers Alert Network (DAN) www.diversalertnetwork.org and Dive Assure www.diveassure.com offer comprehensive insurance packages specifically for scuba divers.

TRIP CONFIRMATION

Day trip passengers will receive confirmation of departure from Adrenalin Snorkel & Dive by 4pm the afternoon prior to your scheduled trip. A trip is only confirmed when the forecasted weather conditions are safe enough to travel and minimum passenger numbers have been met.  Day trips: 20% with 14 days' - 48 hours' notice
 100% with less than 48 hours' notice
 Liveboard / Dive Courses: 20% with 30 – 8 days' notice.
 100% with less than 8 days' notice

Reschedule Fee:
 Day trips: 20% with less than 14 days' notice
 Liveboards: 20% with less than 30 days' notice

REFUND POLICY

Should a trip be cancelled or rescheduled by Adrenalin Snorkel and Dive, a full refund is available. All trips and courses are conditional on weather conditions and participant numbers. All refunds must be authorised by the management of Adrenalin Snorkel and Dive. We endeavour to adhere to the scheduled itinerary but reserve the right to alter the proposed itinerary or cancel the trip. Trip itineraries are subject to change at the sole discretion of the management or master of the vessel. If a trip is delayed, or cut short due to weather, mechanical breakdowns, or medical emergency, fees will not be refunded. THE CENTRAL SECTION GREAT BARRIER HAS SOME OF THE BEST DIVE AND SNORKEL SITES:

Learn about this rich ecosystem from our onboard experts who are available to enlighten, encourage and educate you about the environment below the surface.

Lodestone Reef has many large coral bommies with areas of white sandy bottoms and colourful coral walls in crystal clear water. Be surrounded by a myriad of colourful reef fish including parrot fish, maori wrasse, clown fish, damselfish, angel fish. See turtles, stingrays, white tip and black tip reef sharks.

Keeper Reef is like a coral garden with beautiful gorgonians and spikey soft corals, renowned for its many swim throughs. See coral trout, rabbitfish, batfish, turtles, whitetip reef sharks, sweetlips, barramundi cod, crayfish, rock cods, squirrelfish and shrimps.

Wheeler Reef is one of the premier dive sites in the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park, with a small white sand cay and with areas suited to snorkeling, as well as deep bommies and swim throughs to excite the more experienced diver.

Davies Reef has many dive sites from large pinnacles with small caves to prolific coral gardens and drop-offs, where deep gutters cut through the reef and the walls are decorated with soft corals and gorgonians.

Little Broadhurst Reef is visited on the Liveaboard Trips. Barra Bommie has a swimthrough and regular octopus sightings, and is an excellent night dive location.

The Yongala Wreck, is situated in the World Heritage Great Barrier Reef Marine Park and is protected under the Historical Shipwrecks Act (1976).

The artefacts, marine life and variety of corals that cover the wreck are spectacular. The S.S. Yongala sank during a cyclone in 1911 with the loss of all 122 people on board. Due to its remote location, the wreck was not dived until 1958, remaining mostly untouched and allowing it to become a magnificent artificial reef.

The wreck begins at 14m below the surface and extends to 28m. As it is the only reef structure in the area, the marine life gathers at the wreck. Often seen are gropers, eagle rays, turtles, giant trevally, maori wrasse, bull sharks and thousands of tropical fish. During summer the occasional whale shark and manta ray, and in the cooler months humpback whales, make it a dive you'll never forget.
